

Club Linwood Confirmation of Places and Payments

All applications for places for Club Linwood After School Clubs, Holiday Clubs and Saturday Clubs must be submitted before the closing dates specified in the brochure. Application does not guarantee places, as club is very oversubscribed. Letters regarding placements will be sent to parents within one week of the application closing date.

The costs for clubs are:

After School Clubs - £7 per session (rising to £11.00 on 1st January 2019)

Holiday Clubs - £28 per session

These costs are for families who live within the catchment for subsidised places funded by either Bournemouth or Hampshire Short Breaks. Charges will be reviewed annually in conjunction with Senior Leadership Team.

Costs for non-subsidised places are:

After School Club - £28 per session for 1:1 support, plus £7 attendance (rising to £11 on 1st January 2019)

Holiday Club - £98 per session for 1:1 support, plus £28 attendance

Club Linwood is Ofsted registered under Linwood School, so parents can claim costs of clubs back via tax credits, or use DLA, Direct Payments or own funds. Receipts will be given for all monies paid for Club Linwood places. Places can also be purchased in via Social Care as agreed by individual case workers. Some places may be funded via Pupil Premium/16-18 Bursary Funding on agreement from Linwood School's Senior Leadership Team as required.

Club Linwood acceptance letters will specify a deadline for payments. If payments are not submitted before this date that place will be offered to the next child on the waiting list.

Costs for all Club Linwood activities must be paid up front before the start of each term.

Costs for the full term will be required.

If a family has specific difficulty in paying for a full term up front, it is possible in exceptional circumstances to split payments into two half-termly amounts on agreement of the Extended Services Manager.

There are no refunds if a child misses a session due to sickness or other commitments.

There are no refunds for the remainder of a half term if a child stops attending a club.

If a child wishes to stop attending a club, and parent/carers give notice before half term, they can request a refund for the second half of term.

If a Club Linwood session is cancelled for any reason, then parents will be offered the cost of that club off their next bill, or refunded at end of term if the child ceases to attend clubs.
