Care Information

Linwood Clubs are organised to provide a caring and stimulating environment for children who have Special Needs; whether that is for children who require additional help in order to enjoy an activity or for children with a disability or particular assistance. The Clubs are staffed by Linwood, Springwood and Summerwood Campuses, the Teaching Assistants who work within the school and are trained in all areas of working with special needs children.

Care Passport

In order to help our Extended Services care workers give your child high quality care we ask you to complete a Care Passport. The Care Passport will cover a range of information on your child such as their likes and dislikes, dietary needs, medical requirements and a form on your child's personal care — which is provided by our experienced Extended Services care workers.

Health & Safety

You will be required to sign your children in and out of all After School Clubs and in and out of all Saturday / Holiday Clubs and to confirm that all the relevant contact details we have are up to date and correct for the day.

Medication must be handed over when signing your children in, together with a completed medication form. We can only administer sealed medication which has been prescribed by your **Doctor** and comes to us in a container that has been **dispensed by a Chemist and has the information printed upon it.**

Any medication that **does not** have the correct information on it cannot be administered.

Payment

Both Bournemouth and Hampshire children have subsidised places, pupils from other counties will unfortunately have to pay for the club plus the cost of a carer/s depending on your child's needs. The cost of a carer is £98 per day, this may be paid for using direct payments. The £22.50 cost of club is in addition to this.

Once we have received your completed application form and assigned the pupils to each day's activity we will notify you on which days your child has gained a place. You will then receive the various forms included in Care Passport. These forms and payment **must** be returned by the due date or your children's place will be **lost and reassigned** to the next person on the waiting list.

Clubs may have to be cancelled at short notice due to unforeseen circumstance's.

Late Collection

If a parent/carers is late collecting a child from an Extended Services activity they will be charged an extra £5.00 per 15 minutes.

If the child is left at school past 6pm then Social Services will be called.

After School Clubs and Saturday Activities **September 2018– December 2018**

Term Time Clubs

Monday - Music Club - £7 a session

This club is open to pupils from the Senior phase

A DJ/Music After School Club at Linwood, working with Richard Newland from Aim Community Org a charity that supports music and arts in school settings offering DJ / Music Tech sessions. These sessions are ideal for young people who are not necessarily musicians, but are interested in producing and DJ'ing popular and urban genres, such as Dubstep, Grime, Pop, R n B, Drum and Bass, House and Garage. Learn how to make any style of music! Produce slick beats and bass lines using music technology software and get hands on with mobile digital recording equipment like a professional DJ. The club will run on a **Monday from 3.30pm to 5.30pm**

Tuesday – Linwood After School Club - £7 a session

This club is open to pupils from the Senior phase (11-18)

This popular club will run on Tuesdays for Senior Phase pupils. The sessions will include a variety of fun things to do and includes a range of activities for your child to enjoy as well cooking something for snack. The club will run on a **Tuesday from 3.30pm to 5.30pm**

Wednesday – Sports Club - £7 a session

This club is open to pupils from the Primary and Senior phase

Sports After School Club on a Wednesday will be offering multi sports training, basket ball, tennis, rounders, sitting volleyball, kwik-cricket and football. The club will run on a **Wednesday from 3.30-5.30pm.**

Wednesday/Thursday – Linwood Arts and Movement Club - £7 a session

This club is open to all pupils in both Primary and Senior Phase

Due to popular demand, we will now be providing an Arts and Movement Club on Wednesdays **AND** Thursdays. Each child who wants to attend this club will be allocated one of the days. During these sessions, groups play games and work on themes and topics through drama and movement. On top of having lots of fun, young people can increase in confidence, become more motivated, improve their communication skills and the list doesn't stop there! Linwood Arts and Movement Club will get everyone moving and shaking to the beat, including an end of term show for parents to see. The club will run **Wednesday or Thursday from 3.30 to 5.30pm.**

Thursday - Linwood Football Club - £7 a session

This club is open to all pupils in both Primary and Secondary Phase

The Linwood Football Club runs as an After School Club at Linwood campus on Thursdays during term time. This project enables us to offer football training to children with a wide range of ages, abilities and needs, and is facilitated by our own in house football coaches and PE team. We have forged links with Special Schools across Dorset and so will soon be able to offer regular league matches as well as working with mainstream clubs where appropriate. The club will run on a **Thursday from 3.30 to 5.30pm.**

There will be an increase from January 2019 for After Clubs to £11.00 per session.

HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES

Whether it's a half term or an end of term holiday we run holiday clubs to keep your children entertained. This program is for every holiday we are open, if you are interested in any of these clubs please sign up using the reply slips at the back of the brochure.

TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY HOLIDAY CLUBS 10am - 4pm

We will be running our Holiday Club on Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays. These sessions will be open to all children from Year 1 up to their 18th birthday with an EHCP or a Statement of Educational Needs. We will have a range of activities appropriate to your child's needs. Including craft, sports, sensory play, cookery etc. The cost for Bournemouth and Hampshire based children is subsidized by the local council and therefore their **cost for each session is £22.50**. Unfortunately this does not apply to children outside of the Bournemouth/Hampshire area and we have to charge the full daily rate. This rate cover the carer for your child (depending on your child's needs) and the running of the club. The cost for a carer is £98.00 per session and the cost for the club per day is £22.50.

SIBS CLUBS 10am—4pm

SIBS is a youth group for young people who have a sibling with a learning disability. SIBS sessions are open to young people from 5 1/2 to 17 years old.

SIBS provides a range of activities each session including: computer games, cooking, arts & crafts, sports. SIBS also explores the issues that affect those with a sibling who has a learning disability. This is often supported by a range of professionals who provide expert advice on a specific issue or topic. SIBS is £5 per day for each child to attend, although more if they go on a trip. This is open to all Siblings of a special needs child from Bournemouth, Poole and East Dorset.
