

HOW TO APPLY FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS - 2021/22

What you need to do:

1. You will only be eligible if you are receiving a qualifying benefit. Please use the table below to establish whether you are eligible for Free School Meals before you apply:



Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

Children under the compulsory school age who are in full time, state-maintained nursery education (nurseries that are based at a Primary School) may also be able to get free school meals.

- 2. Complete the application form fully and provide **all** the information we have asked for so that we can carry out a benefit check. You **do not** have to send in evidence of the benefits you receive unless we ask you to.
- 3. Send your form to us. If your child attends a Bournemouth or Christchurch school, please email your completed form to: fsm@bcpcouncil.gov.uk.

When we receive your completed application:

- We will check your benefit entitlement with data held by the Department of Work and Pensions, the Home Office and HMRC (Revenue and Customs) through a central Eligibility Checking System (ECS).
 If we cannot confirm your entitlement though this process, we will write to you to ask you to provide up-to-date evidence of the benefits you receive.
- We will confirm your Free School Meals eligibility by email. If you have not provided an email address, we will write to the address that you have used on this application.
- We will inform your child's school of your child's Free School Meals eligibility.
