The governing board members:

- Set the strategic direction for the school.
- Hold the Executive Headteacher to account for school finances and student outcomes.
- Work to improve outcomes for every student across Linwood, governors are “eyes on, hands off”.
- Have a real impact; e.g. led Executive Headteacher recruitment and appointment in 2021
- Is filled with experienced and tenacious governors who have ambitious outcomes for the whole school community.

Your commitment:

- Five, 2-hour Full Governing Board meetings a year, 10am-noon on Wednesdays, virtual via Teams.
- Be a member of one committee depending on your experience and background, Finance and Resources or Learning and Achievement. These sub groups meet virtually once a term, Wednesday mornings for 2 hours (3 per year).
- Pre-reading for meetings - come with questions!
- Induction and ongoing training – mainly online, occasionally in-person.
- Visit a campus to meet with staff and students, as directed by the board, no more than once a term.

Why do it?

- Collectively, governors support the Executive Head Teacher and Senior Leadership Team to lead the school. It's a real chance to make a difference for all students within the school.
- Governors learn many skills and gain a deep knowledge of Special Education. There are opportunities for leadership and personal and professional growth.
